

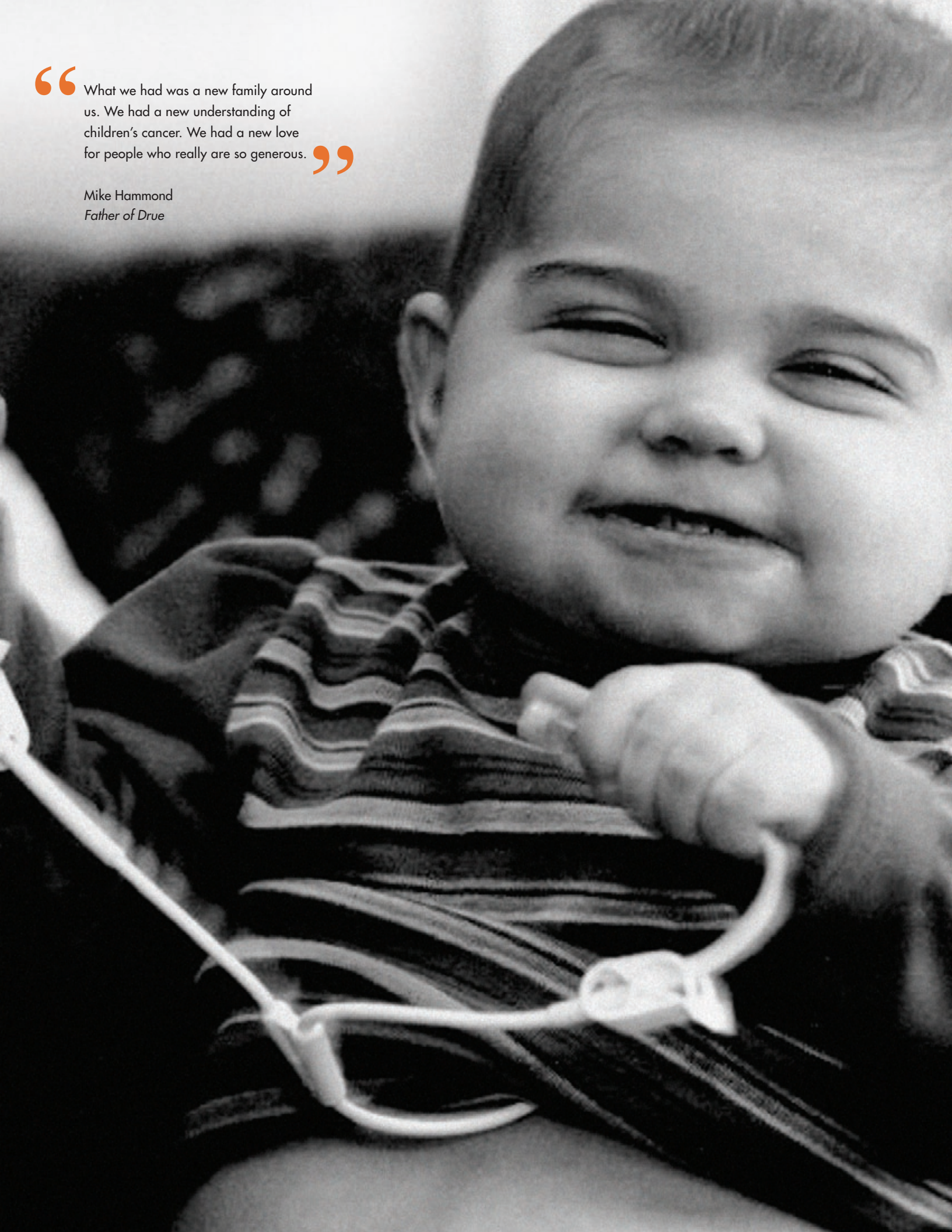

You may be wondering what prompted us to publish our first-ever annual report. I can answer that in two words – **big dreams**. It's been an amazing year and we have big dreams to accomplish some major tasks in the next year or two. We wanted to tell you about where we've been, where we're headed, and how you can help.

We're driven by our mission to help children living with cancer – and their families – by providing housing, programs, and partnerships in the community. After our 14-year-old son Brent was taken by cancer in 1988, we vowed to honor his spirit and courage by making a difference in the lives of children with cancer. Thanks to our staff, donors, volunteers, and doctors throughout the Rocky Mountain Region, we are fulfilling that vow.

In 2005, we provided a “safe clean” home away from home for 56 individual families who stayed with us, on average, 59 days. Those families also enjoyed our Monday night family dinners, personal chef program, outings and 24/7 support from our staff. Programs were funded primarily by community contributions, including grants, and four special events involving almost 3000 participants. Dr. Stella Davis, a well-recognized childhood cancer epidemiologist from Cincinnati was the Brent Eley Visiting Professor. Dr. Chris Porter, a Fellow in the CU/TCH cancer program was awarded \$50,000 as the Brent Eley/Brian Hicks Memorial Research Fellow. In summary, we made a difference and fulfilled our mission in 2005.

I mentioned big dreams and plans for the future. The Children's Hospital, which refers over half of Brent's Place families, will be moving to the new Fitzsimons Medical Center Campus. We have identified a building site and completed the schematic design for a new Brent's Place that will be just one mile from this new hospital location. We've launched a capital campaign that will help us fund this new facility that we hope to open in 2008. We would like to invite you to be part of the team that makes this *big dream* come true, and we will continue to fulfill our commitment to help children living with cancer.

I smiled because these definitions encapsulate perfectly what Brent’s Place is all about. And I had been struggling with how I was possibly going to describe this amazing place to you in one short letter for this first-ever annual report.

We’re home. A home for hope and healing for children with cancer and their families.

A “safe clean” environment where camaraderie and support abound and families are surrounded with people with the same hopes, dreams, concerns. A community where meals and outings are shared and enjoyed, and compassion knows no bounds.

We’re home. The home of important pediatric cancer research.

Each year, we award a grant to a Junior Faculty Member or postdoctoral Fellow in the field of pediatric oncology. One of our former fellows is now on staff at The Children’s Hospital.

We’re home. A source of joy and profound hope. The children, their families, our volunteers, donors, and staff come together to fill this place with laughter – even in the face of some of life’s biggest challenges.

Up to 75% of children with cancer can be treated with first line therapy such as radiation or chemotherapy. Brent’s Place is a home for those children who fall into the remaining 25% – those who need aggressive chemotherapy, bone marrow transplantation, or experimental protocols.

We have a simple, basic mission – to provide a “safe clean” home for children and their families seeking treatment in Denver for the most life threatening, aggressive forms of cancer. And we have been fulfilling that mission since 1998.
